Our filtering system restricts access to inappropriate materials, and all children are taught Internet safety which includes teaching the safe and appropriate behaviours to adopt when using the Internet, digital communication and other technologies.

During school, teachers will guide children towards appropriate and suitable material. At home, families have the same responsibility for guidance as they exercise with other information sources such as television, phones, films and radio.

Although all Internet use is supervised and filtered within our school, and our teachers are conscientious in preparing lessons with only child friendly material, occasionally some material that is inaccurate, defamatory, illegal, or potentially offensive to some people may be accessed. The school therefore supports and respects each family's right to decide whether or not to allow access to the Internet or digital communication.

Copies of our policies are available in the main reception which explains in more detail our approach to Internet and ICT safety.
