Dear Parent/Carer,

Following on from our success over the past two years of winning the participation trophy (the highest number of children selected across the Mini Youth Games series of any school), I would like to let you know how your child can be part of these sporting opportunities.

The clubs timetable will specify which clubs are specifically for MYG events. For example, 'MYG Hockey, MYG badminton' etc. Children attending these clubs will be first in the selection process based on ability, although for some events, such as table tennis and badminton, teams are made up of 6 children, so 18 children across the three teams, which means if the club has 24 children attending, there would be 6 children who are not selected (depending on the girl-boy ratio). If we are short of girls to make up the teams, we will then choose girls from our Girls Sports Development lunchtime club (invite only, but I'm happy to add any girls who are keen to join).

Any additional girls or boys required, will be selected based on performance and attitude to learning, within PE lessons.

Once selected, Mrs Tillet will only grant permission for children to attend if they continuously display our school values, and any significant behaviour incidents will result in the child being removed from the team.

At Fairview, we strive to give as many children as possible the opportunity to represent the school, but even with this in mind, unfortunately some children still may not be selected. To give your child the best chance of selection, encourage them to sign up to as many 'MYG' clubs as possible. We all have different skills and talents, and even if they have never tried a particular sport, they may have a natural aptitude for it.
