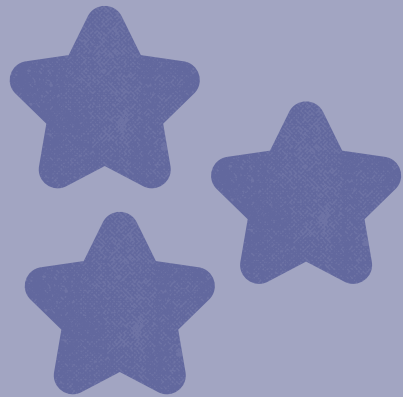




Fairview Community Primary School

At Fairview, we are proud of our school values, which underpin everything we do and are core to the ethos of our school. The agreement below represents the shared commitment of the school, parents/carers and children to develop progress and success for all children during their time at Fairview.

As staff we will:

Perseverance

- Achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility.
- Create a culture where it is ok to take risks and mistakes are an opportunity for deeper learning.

Kindness

- Care for your child's safety and happiness.
 - Encourage the children to believe in themselves, feel valued and reach their full potential.
- Be open and welcoming at all times and provide opportunities for you to become involved in the life of the school.
- Engage positively with parents and carers.

Responsibility

- Be positive role models in our behaviour and conduct around the school.
- Be consistent in approaches to behaviour.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum and learning opportunities.
- Ensure your child's physical and social well-being needs are met at all times, and to foster feelings of confidence, self-worth and belonging.

Collaboration

- Share ideas between teachers to provide a balanced, stimulating and well taught curriculum to meet the individual needs of the children.
- Keep you informed about school matters and your child's progress.
 - Contact parents at an early stage if concerns arise

Respect

- Treat pupils as individuals, getting to know them and respecting them.
- Ensure all pupils have a voice and their viewpoint and opinion is respected.

Honesty

- Keep you informed about school matters and your child's progress.
 - Contact parents at an early stage if concerns arise

As parents/carers we will:

Perseverance

- Support my child in his/her homework and wherever possible promote opportunities for home learning.

Kindness

- Speak to all member of the school community with courtesy and kindness.

Responsibility

- Make sure that my child attends each day and has a termly attendance of at least 96%
- Make sure my child arrives on time and is properly equipped for school.
- Inform the school on the first day of any absence.

Collaboration

- Make the school aware of any concerns or issues that might affect my child's behaviour or learning.
- Support the school's behaviour policy.
- Work with the school to share concerns and resolve issues.
 - Attend parent's evenings
- Be interested in my child's life at school

Respect

- Be a positive role model for my child.

Honesty

- Inform the school of any concerns that may affect my child's learning and behaviour
- Work with the school at an early stage to resolve these.

As a pupil I will:

Perseverance

- Do my best in my classwork and my homework.
- Keep trying even when I find something challenging.

Kindness

- Be polite and helpful to others.

Responsibility

- Come to school every day, be on time and ready to learn.
- Be well behaved and sensible.
 - Follow our school values.
- Wear my school uniform and take pride in my appearance.
- Take care of school equipment, the school buildings and the surroundings.
- Pass on information to my parents.

Collaboration

- Share and talk about any problems I have and ask for help when I need it.
- Work with adults and children in the school listening and sharing ideas.

Respect

- Respect all members of my school community and their property.
- Listen to the ideas and views of others even when they are different from my own.

Honesty

- Tell the truth in all situations and own up to any mistakes.
 - Ask for help when I need it.
