Welcome back for the start of Term 2! From all of us on the Year 4 team, we hope you had a lovely half term!



stories.





Our topic this term is celebrating


difference using our Jigsaw scheme. We will look at our similarities

- We will focus on times tables as there will be an assessment online at the end of year 4 therefore there is the expectation that Trockstars is used regularly and tasks and battles will be set weekly.
