Our focus texts in English will start with *Naughty Bus* by Jan & Jerry Oke, followed by *Lost and Found* by Oliver Jeffers. We are really excited for this learning!

English

This term in English, we will be exploring the texts, *Naughty Bus* by Jan & Jerry Oke, followed by *Lost and Found* by Oliver Jeffers. We will be learning about letters, diaries, and adjectives.



Maths

In maths this term we are going to be exploring place value within 10. This will include sorting, counting, 1 more, 1 less, less than, greater than, equal to and comparing and ordering numbers. We will explore this through different provision activities.



Science

In science we will be learning about different everyday materials. We will be identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock, and describing their properties.



History

This term in history, we will be learning about George Stephenson and how he used the steam engine to help to build a locomotive that ran on rails. Also, how he helped to build the first steam train to carry passengers.



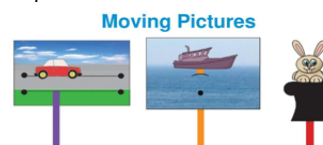
Computing

In computing we will be learning about how to stay safe on the internet. We will then learn the different parts of a computer and how to log on.



DT

In DT In Design Technology, we will be making a variety of moving pictures using different mechanisms, including sliders, levers, pivots, and wheels.



RE

This term, we will be learning the Jewish and Christian Creation Story and thinking about the question: How did the world begin?



PE

In PE this term, we will be learning 'gymnastic' indoors and 'attack, defend and shoot' outdoors.

PSHE

In PSHE this term, we will be exploring 'Being Me in My World'. Part of this is to understand what it means to be a member of the class, and to recognise the choices they make and understand the consequences.
